1. Apply as a Degree-Seeking Student to Tillamook Bay Community College.

3. Submit official (or unofficial) high school (and/or previous college) transcripts.
4. Include official copies of Placement Assessment Results (Smarter Balance, Accuplacer, ACT, SAT, etc.). If you do not have recent scores, allow yourself time to take the Accuplacer assessment here at TBCC and submit the paper copy of those scores. This test is free and is available to take in our library Monday through Friday from 8 a.m5 p.m. No appointment is needed.
5. Provide verification of the completion of the federal financial aid (FAFSA) application.
6. Write a one-page essay explaining your future career plans and how continuing your education will help make these plans happen.

7. Complete the Proposed Career Education Plan form. Follow the link to our website for information to use in completion of the plan. Click on the degree type you are pursuing, then you can look at the "Two-Year Degree Map" to see the courses that are offered each term that would be applicable to completing that degree. Career-to-Career Scholars Program 2017

Tillamook Bay Community College is pleased to open 24 slots in our TBCC Career-to-Career program for local individuals in the 2017-2018 academic year.

The *Career-to-Career Program 2017* is a tuition scholarship available to qualified Tillamook County individuals in a career who need support to transition to a new career or a promotion. As long as the student maintains his or her eligibility, Tillamook Bay Community College will award a tuition scholarship for fall, winter, and spring terms for the 2017-2018 and the 2018-2019 school years or until the student earns his or her first degree, whichever comes first. Students must be on one of two Career-to-Career Education Paths. Selection for the Career-to-Career Program will be based on the evaluation of the completed application packet.

Option 1: Career Technical Path (CTE): 12 openings available

You plan to earn an **Associate of Applied Science degree** in *Agriculture and Natural Resources, Business Administration, Criminal Justice and Public Safety, Manufacturing & Industrial Technology.*

Option 2: University Transfer Path: 12 openings available

You plan to earn a degree to allow you to **transfer to a Bachelor's degree program**. Your declared major is Associate of Arts Oregon Transfer, Associate of Science, Associate of Science Oregon Transfer in Business, or Associate of General Studies.

Qualification Process: Important Dates & Information

- **June 1, 2017- September 1, 2017:** Apply to be a degree-seeking student at TBCC. You must apply as a "Degree-Seeking Student" on the TBCC website at www.tillamookbaycc.edu.
- June 1, 2017- September 1, 2017 by 4:30 p.m.: Submit this application page and all required documents in one packet to TBCC Student Services, 4301 Third St. Tillamook, 97141. No late submissions will be accepted Applicants will be notified of the scholarship within two weeks of submission by TBCC email address. Upon acceptance into the program, you will then need to contact the Student Services office to sign up for the August 7 Enhanced Orientation Day, which will include a session on the Career-to-Career Scholar Program (CCS)
- August 7: Attend the Enhanced Orientation session on August 7. After completing this program, you will receive confirmation of your award at your TBCC email address. Print out, sign, and return a copy of this letter to TBCC's Student Services office. (IF YOU SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION AFTER August 7, contact Student Services for information.)
- August-September: Enroll at least half time taking 6 credits or more at TBCC. Maintain a 3.0 GPA.

Eligibility Requirements

Initial eligibility requirements:

- Application submitted by September 1, 2017;
- Completion of at least five years of verifiable employment;
- Submission of high school and/or previous college transcripts;
- Verification of successful FAFSA application;
- Placement assessment results indicating Writing 121 and Math 095 (or higher) for transfer programs, MTH 070 for CTE programs.
- Completion of a two-year Proposed Career Education Plan;
- Submission of an **essay** outlining future career goals.

Requirements to maintain eligibility

- Enroll at least half-time in the fall of 2017 (NOTE: the program will only pay the amount of the initial enrollment level in each of the following terms);
- Maintain a GPA of 3.0 or higher (2.5 for CTE programs).
- Follow the Proposed Career Education Plan (CEP), maintaining original enrollment levels, and meet with a career education advisor as needed to make modifications to the CEP.

Application packets will be accepted beginning June 1, 2017, ending on September 1, 2017 by 4:30 p.m.
