- Enroll in a minimum of 8 credit hours
- Demonstrated financial need

- Completion of FAFSA application - attach only confirmation printout that shows EFC number
- Unofficial TBCC transcripts
- One page essay: Explain your career aspirations and your educational plan to meet these goals.
