

First Class Scholars Program Scholarship Application 2018

The *TBCC First Class Scholars Program 2018* is a tuition scholarship available to qualified Tillamook County high school or home school graduates. As long as the student maintains his or her eligibility, Tillamook Bay Community College will award a tuition scholarship for fall, winter, and spring terms for the 2018 and 2019 years or until the student earns his or her first degree, whichever comes first. Selection for the program will be based on the quality and completeness of the application and essay. *Typically we have been able to award this scholarship to between 15-20 students annually*!

Eligibility Requirements:

Career Technical Degree Option

- Graduate from a Tillamook County high school 2018
- Earn a cumulative unweighted GPA of 2.5 or better by the end of first semester of senior year
 - Be eligible to enroll in Math 70 and Writing 121

University Transfer Degree Option

- Graduate from a Tillamook County high school in 2018
- Earn a cumulative unweighted GPA of 3.0 or better by the end of first semester of senior year
 - Eligible to enroll in Math 95 and Writing 121

Suggested Completion Timeline

- 1. Apply to be a degree-seeking student at TBCC. College Now or dual credit students still must re-apply.
- 2. Apply for the Oregon Promise Grant and FAFSA.
- February 1, 2018 through April 6, 2018 Submit your <u>complete</u> application packet to *TBCC Student Services, 4301 Third St. Tillamook, OR* 97141 by 4:30 p.m. No late submissions will be accepted.
- May
 - 1. Attend a meeting at the high school with a TBCC Career Education Advisor.
 - 2. Complete Priority Pre-Registration for fall classes at that meeting!
 - 3. Request your high school registrar verify your GPA for the Oregon Promise Grant before June 1.

June

Request your high school registrar send your final high school transcript to TBCC before July 1, 2017.

August

- 1. Attend the TBCC Enhanced Orientation on August 21, from 9-3 p.m. at TBCC.
- 2. After the orientation, watch your TBCC email for your Scholarship Award Letter. Print it out, sign it and return it to TBCC--Student Services (mail, fax, scan, or bring in) *in order to receive your funding.*
- **September**: Classes begin! To maintain funding eligibility, you must maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA and attend one First Class Scholar Cohort meeting per term for the duration of the scholarship.
