

# Career-to-Career Scholars Program Scholarship Application Fall 2018

The *Career-to-Career Program 2018* is a tuition scholarship available to qualified Tillamook County individuals in a career who need support to transition to a new career or to improve job skills for their current career. As long as the student maintains his or her eligibility, Tillamook Bay Community College will award a tuition scholarship for fall, winter, and spring of the 2018-2019 and the 2019-2020 school years (or until the student earns his or her first degree, whichever comes first). Students must be on one of two Career-to-Career Education Pathways. Selection for the Career-to-Career Program will be based on the quality and completeness of this application packet and the required essay.

### **Eligibility Requirements:**

### **Career Technical Degree Option**

- Completion of a high school diploma/GED (five years ago or beyond);
  - Verification of successful FAFSA application (see <u>www.fafsa.gov</u>)
    - Be eligible to enroll in Math 70 and Writing 121 (based upon previous college transcripts or our free placement exam)

### **University Transfer Degree Option**

- Completion of a high school diploma/GED (five years ago or beyond);
  - Verification of successful FAFSA application (see <u>www.fafsa.gov</u>)
    - Be eligible to enroll in Math 95 and Writing 121

#### Maintaining Eligibility for the Scholarship

Once accepted into the *Career to Career Scholars Program*, students are required to do the following to maintain eligibility for funding:

- 1. Meet with a Financial Aid Advisor annually;
- 2. Attend quarterly Career Scholars Cohort Meetings with President Ross Tomlin;
- 3. Attend monthly Student Success Meetings with a Career Education Advisor;
- 4. Maintain a 2.5 GPA if in the CTE program or a 3.0 GPA if in the University Transfer program;
- 5. Maintain a working Career Education Plan, developed in the *CG100: College Survival and Success* course and reviewed quarterly with your advisor.
