



## ***Career-to-Career Scholars Program***

### **Scholarship Application**

### **Spring 2019**

The ***Career-to-Career Program 2019*** is a tuition scholarship available to qualified Tillamook County individuals in a career (or who are underemployed) who need support to transition to a new career or to improve job skills for their current career or a new one. As long as the student maintains his or her eligibility, Tillamook Bay Community College will award a tuition scholarship for the 2018-2019 and the 2019-2020 school years (or until the student earns his or her first degree, whichever comes first). Students must be on one of two Career-to-Career Education Pathways. Selection for the Career-to-Career Program will be based on the quality and completeness of this application packet and the required essay.

#### **Eligibility Requirements:**

##### **Career Technical Degree Option**

- **Completion of a high school diploma/GED (five years ago or beyond);**
- **Verification of successful FAFSA application (see [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov))**
  - **Be eligible to enroll in Math 70 and Writing 121**  
(based upon previous college transcripts or our free placement exam)

##### **University Transfer Degree Option**

- **Completion of a high school diploma/GED (five years ago or beyond);**
- **Verification of successful FAFSA application (see [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov))**
  - **Be eligible to enroll in Math 95 and Writing 121**  
(based upon previous college transcripts or our free placement exam)

### Maintaining Eligibility for the Scholarship

Once accepted into the *Career-to-Career Scholars Program*, students are required to do the following to maintain eligibility for funding:

1. Meet with a Financial Aid Advisor annually;
2. Attend quarterly Career Scholars Cohort Meetings with President Ross Tomlin;
3. Complete three hours of campus volunteer activities each term;
4. Maintain a 2.5 GPA if in the CTE program or a 3.0 GPA if in the University Transfer program;
5. Maintain a working Career Education Plan, developed in the *CG100: College Survival and Success* course and review quarterly with your advisor.
