The ***Career-to-Career Program 2020*** is a tuition scholarship available to qualified Tillamook County individuals in a career who need support to transition to a new career or to improve job skills for their current career. As long as the student maintains his or her eligibility, TBCC will award a tuition scholarship for the 2020-21 and the 2021-2022 school years (or until the student earns his or her first degree, whichever comes first). Students must be on one of two Career-to-Career Education Pathways.

Eligibility Requirements:

Career Technical Degree Option

- Completion of a high school diploma/GED (five years ago or beyond);
- Verification of successful FAFSA or ORSAA application (see www.fafsa.ed.gov or www.oregonstudentaid.gov);
 - Preference will be given to applicants who are eligible to enroll in Writing 121

University Transfer Degree Option

- Completion of a high school diploma/GED (five years ago or beyond);
- Verification of successful FAFSA/ORSAA application (see www.fafsa.ed.gov or www.oregonstudentaid.gov);
 - Preference will be given to applicants who are eligible to enroll in Writing 121

Maintaining Eligibility for the Scholarship

Once accepted into the *Career-to-Career Scholars Program*, students are required to do the following to maintain eligibility for funding:

1. Meet with a Financial Aid Advisor annually;
2. Attend quarterly Career Scholars Cohort Meetings with President Ross Tomlin;
3. Participate in a minimum of three hours of campus community service or training activities each quarter;
4. Maintain a 2.5 GPA if in the CTE program or a 3.0 GPA if in the University Transfer program; and
5. Maintain a working Career Education Plan, developed in the *CG100: College Survival and Success* course and reviewed quarterly with your advisor.
