PAYING FOR COLLEGE / SCHOLARSHIPS

DeArmond Scholarship (multiple up to \$2,500): This scholarship is intended to assist a TBCC student to complete a degree in one of the following programs: Welding Technology, Emergency Medical Services, Medical Assisting, Business Administration, Criminal Justice and Public Safety, or Manufacturing and Industrial Technology. Funds are split between fall, winter, and spring terms, and can be used for tuition, fees, books, and educational supplies.

Kiwanis Club of Tillamook – Lyle Specht Memorial Scholarship (up to \$1,250): This scholarship is intended to assist a TBCC student in their second year of a degree or certificate program. Funds are split between fall, winter, and spring terms, and can only be used for tuition.

Mario and Alma Pastega Family Scholarship (multiple up to \$4,000 each): This scholarship is intended to assist a degree or certificate-seeking student who has given a helping hand to someone within the community, and who intends to lend a hand in the future. Funds are split between fall, winter, and spring terms, and can be used toward tuition, fees, and books.

Mildred Davy Endowed Scholarship (up to \$1,500): This scholarship is intended to assist a TBCC student working towards their first degree or certificate. Funds are split between fall, winter, and spring terms, and can be used for tuition, fees and books.

Peggy Maack Memorial Endowed Scholarship (\$500): This scholarship is intended to assist a pre-nursing student at TBCC. Funds are split between fall, winter, and spring terms, and can be used for tuition, fees, and books.
