One application has been received for the open Board position in Zone 4. The Board will interview the candidate using the questions below.

- 1. What skills would you bring to the TBCC Board that would be beneficial to the college?
- 2. Being a member of TBCC's board of education is a commitment of your time. Do you feel you have the time available to meet these obligations? Some of the responsibilities of board members that would require time each month include:
 - i. Preparation for an attendance at monthly board meetings by reading through the board packet before the meeting and developing questions to ask about the material.
 - ii. Involvement in professional organizations, like Oregon Community College Association (OCCA), which may involve local travel as well as overnight travel out of county on a monthly basis if acting as the Board representative on the OCCA Board.
 - iii. Legislative activities and civic events.
 - iv. Serving on the TBCC Budget Committee to approve the college budget annually. This typically involves one extra meeting in April each year, along with preparation by reading through the budget document.
 - v. Serving on a TBCC Board Committee each year which sometimes involves extra meetings.

This person will serve on the TBCC Board through June 2023, and will need to run in the May 2023 election to fill the remaining 2 years of term to which they are appointed. This term will expire in June 2025. They will then need to run for re-election for the full 4 year term for 2025-2029.
