

Career-to-Career Scholars Program Scholarship Application

The *Career-to-Career Scholars Program* is a **tuition** scholarship available to qualified Tillamook County individuals who need support transitioning to a new career or to improve job skills for their current career. As long as the student maintains eligibility, TBCC will award a tuition scholarship for the current and upcoming academic years (or until the student earns their first degree, <u>whichever comes first</u>).

Eligibility Requirements:

- Completion of a high school diploma/GED (five years ago or beyond);
 - Verification of successful FAFSA or ORSAA application

Maintaining Eligibility for the Scholarship

Once accepted into the *Career-to-Career Scholars Program*, students are required to do the following to maintain eligibility for funding:

- 1. Meet with a Financial Aid Advisor annually;
- 2. Attend quarterly Career Scholars Cohort Meetings with President Paul Jarrell;
- 3. Participate in a minimum of three hours of campus community service or training activities each quarter;
- 4. Maintain a 2.5 GPA if in the CTE program or a 3.0 GPA if in the University Transfer program; and
- 5. Maintain a working Career Education Plan, developed with your Success Coach.
