ADVISORY COMMITTEES

The College President may establish citizen advisory committees to assist the Board and the College in exploring the needs of the College.

The College President or personnel designated by the College President shall be authorized to establish such internal committees, councils, and advisory groups deemed necessary for the organization and administration of the College.

The College Dean of Career-Technical Education shall be authorized to establish Career and Technical Education Program Advisory Committees made up primarily of private-sector members to support and strengthen programs and promote greater cooperation between Career and Technical Education at Tillamook Bay Community College and business/industry. Advisory Committees will have three major roles: 1) to advise, 2) to assist, 3) to support and advocate for career and technical education at Tillamook Bay Community College.
