PURPOSE

The college values student and stakeholder input and maintains multiple avenues to collect this input including the following;

- A. Student surveys that have been approved by the college Leadership Team;
- B. Course evaluations for every course taken;
- C. Advisory Board input;
- D. Community surveys that have been approved by the college Leadership Team; and other avenues as determined appropriate via the Leadership Team.

Student input on college committees is valuable for the student, staff and community. Committee work provides a learning experience for students as well as an opportunity to be an active participant in the policy-making and environment shaping of the college community.

Policies have a major impact on Tillamook Bay Community College's mission to recruit and retain students, and student input provides staff with the viewpoint of the individuals we are hired to serve. It also provides employees the opportunity, as educators, to mentor and pass on "lab experience" in group process, communication, decision-making and other life-long skills.

Committees are an integral part of the Tillamook Bay Community College's policy-making process; therefore, Tillamook Bay Community College committees that recommend, formulate, or review policy shall ask for a student member
