AAUW Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to support a student enrolled at TBCC and pursuing a degree or certificate. Applicants must be a resident of Tillamook County, enroll in at least 6 credit hours per term and maintain a 2.5 GPA. Funds are split over fall, winter, and spring terms, and can be used for tuition, fees, and books.

Arthur and Janet Riedel Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to assist a student enrolled at TBCC and pursuing a degree or certificate. Applicants must be a resident of Tillamook County for at least 4 years, enroll in at least 12 credit hours per term, maintain a 2.5 GPA, and demonstrate financial need. Funds are split over fall, winter, and spring terms, and can be used toward tuition, fees, and books.

Benjamin G. Nunez and Priscilla Gleason Nunez Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to support a student enrolled at TBCC seeking to obtain a degree or certificate. Applicants must enroll in at least 12 credit hours per term and maintain a 2.75 GPA. Funds are split between fall, winter, and spring terms, and may be used for tuition, fees, textbooks, and educational supplies.

Buck and Elnora Monroe Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to support a student at TBCC to obtain a degree or certificate, with a preference given to a sole caregiver of a minor(s) returning to get their education, or a veteran of the United States Armed Forces. Applicants must enroll in at least 6 credit hours per term, maintain a 2.5 GPA, and demonstrate financial need. Funds are split between fall, winter, and spring terms, and can be used for tuition, fees, books, educational supplies, and childcare.

Casey-Green Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to assist a first-generation, part-time, degree or certificate-seeking TBCC student, who is currently an employed sole caregiver to a minor(s). Applicants must enroll in 6-10 credit hours per term and maintain a 2.0 GPA. Funds are split over fall, winter, and spring terms, and can be used for tuition, fees, books, educational supplies, and childcare.

DeArmond Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to assist a TBCC student to complete a degree in one of the following programs: Agriculture and Natural Resources, Business Administration, Criminal Justice and Public Safety Emergency Medical Services, Medical Assisting, or Manufacturing and Industrial Technology. Applicants must have completed at least 24 credit hours at TBCC, maintain a 2.5 GPA, enroll in at least 8 credit hours per term, and demonstrate financial need. Funds are split between fall, winter, and spring terms, and can be used for tuition, fees, books, and educational supplies.

Doug Wright & Susan Lynch Nursing Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to assist a TBCC nursing student. Preference is given to first generation students. Applicants must enroll in at least 6 credit hours per term and maintain a 3.0 GPA. Funds are split over fall, winter, and spring terms, and can be used for tuition, fees, books, educational supplies, living expenses and childcare.

Dr. Paul Betlinski Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to assist a TBCC student studying for a position in the healthcare field. Applicant must be a resident of Tillamook County for at least 4 years, enroll in at least 8 credit hours per term, and maintain a 2.0 GPA. Funds are split over fall, winter, and spring terms, and can be used for tuition, fees, books, and educational supplies. Consecutive funding possible, subject to satisfactory academic performance and funding.

Esther Milne – Pat Sears Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to assist a degree or certificate-seeking student returning to education. Preference is given to students living in South Tillamook County. Funds are split over fall, winter, and spring terms, and can be used for tuition, fees, books, educational supplies, childcare, and living expenses.

Futuro Brillante Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to assist a TBCC student pursuing a degree or certificate at TBCC, with preference given to a Latinx student. Applicants must enroll in at least 12 credit hours per term and maintain a 3.0 GPA. Funds are split between fall, winter, and spring terms, and can be used for tuition, fees, books, and educational supplies.

Gilda J. Brown Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to assist a TBCC student who is seeking a degree in nursing and is enrolled in the TBCC Nursing Program. Applicants must enroll in at least 6 credits per term, maintain a 3.0 GPA, and demonstrate financial need. The funds are split between fall, winter, and spring terms, and can be used for tuition, fees, and books.

Hampton Lumber Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to support a TBCC student who is pursuing a degree in Forestry or Manufacturing and Industrial Technology. The funds are split between fall, winter and spring terms and can be used for tuition, fees, books, educational supplies, childcare and living expenses.

John R. and Janet J. Stahl, Gloria Languedoc Memorial Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to support a TBCC student who is pursuing an education in the arts and letters learning community. Applicants must maintain a 3.0 GPA. Funds are split between fall, winter and spring terms and can be used for tuition, fees, books, educational supplies, childcare and living expenses.

Juntos Afuera Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to support a TBCC student that has participated in the Juntos Afuera summer camp. Applicants must maintain a 2.5 GPA. Funds are split between fall, winter and spring terms and can be used for tuition, fees, books, educational supplies, childcare and living expenses.

J.M. “Jim” Brown Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to assist a degree or certificate-seeking, TBCC student who shows great promise, but has limited funds for higher education. Applicants must enroll in at least 6 credits per term, maintain a 3.0 GPA, and demonstrate financial need. Funds are split between fall, winter, and spring terms, and can be used for tuition, fees, and books.

Kiwanis Club of Tillamook - Lyle Specht Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to assist a TBCC student in their second year of a degree or certificate program. Applicants must be a resident of Tillamook County, have completed at least 32 credit hours at TBCC, maintain a 2.75 GPA, enroll in at least 12 credit hours per term, and demonstrate financial need. Funds are split between fall, winter, and spring terms, and can be used for tuition.

Loren E. Parks Trust Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to support a TBCC student who is pursuing an education in the healthcare pathways learning community. Applicants must maintain a 3.0 GPA. Funds are split between fall, winter, and spring terms, and can be used to cover tuition, fees, and books, educational supplies, childcare and living expenses.

M. Wayne Jensen Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to assist a degree or certificate-seeking adult returning to education as part of employment and/or personal change. Applicants must maintain a 2.75 GPA and demonstrate financial need. Funds are split between fall, winter, and spring terms, and can be used to cover tuition, fees, and books.

The Matthew Rehl Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to support a TBCC student pursuing a degree or certificate in a Career Technical Education (CTE) program. Applicants must enroll in at least 6 credits per term and maintain a 2.0 GPA. Preference is given to part-time students and first-generation students. The funds are split between fall, winter and spring terms, and can be used for tuition, fees, books and educational supplies.

Mario and Alma Pastega Family Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to assist a degree or certificate-seeking student who has given a helping hand to someone within the community, and who intends to give a hand in the future. Applicants must be a resident of Tillamook County for at least 4 years, enroll in at least 12 credit hours per term, and maintain a 2.5 GPA. Funds are split between fall, winter, and spring terms, and can be used toward tuition, fees, and books.

Mary Lou Hudson Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to assist a degree-seeking student at TBCC. Applicants must be an Oregon resident, enroll in at least 6 credit hours per term, maintain a 2.75 GPA, and demonstrate financial need. Funds are split between fall, winter, and spring terms, and can be used for tuition, fees, books, education supplies, childcare, and living expenses.

Mildred Davy Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to assist a degree or certificate-seeking student at TBCC. Applicant must be a resident of Tillamook County, enroll in at least 6 credit hours, maintain a 2.0 GPA, and demonstrate financial need. Funds are split between fall, winter, and spring terms, and can be used for tuition, fees and books, educational supplies, living expenses and childcare.

Nehalem Bay Emergency Services Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to enhance and promote strong leadership and skilled professionals in the fire, EMS, and law enforcement fields by assisting a TBCC student studying in those fields. Applicants must enroll in at least 6 credit hours per term and maintain a 3.0 GPA. Funds are split between fall, winter, and spring terms, and can be used for tuition, fees, books, educational supplies, childcare, and living expenses.

Oceanside-Netarts Vera Snow-Reid Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to assist a TBCC student pursuing a nursing degree. Preference is given to residents of Oceanside or Netarts. Applicants must enroll in at least 6 credit hours. Funds are split between fall, winter, and spring terms, and can be used for tuition, fees, and books.

Patsy L. and Christian J. Weber Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to assist a degree or certificate seeking student at TBCC. Preference is given to second year students. Applicants must enroll in at least 6 credits per term and maintain a 2.50 GPA. Funds are split between fall, winter, and spring terms, and can be used for tuition, fees and books, educational supplies, living expenses and childcare.

Peggy Maack Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to assist a pre-nursing student at TBCC. Applicants must enroll in at least 6 credits per term, maintain a 3.0 GPA, and demonstrate financial need. Funds are split between fall, winter, and spring terms, and can only be used for tuition, fees, and books.

Robert and Alicia Reed Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to support an existing TBCC student, with a preference given to a student enrolled in the Forestry, Agriculture and Natural Resources Program. Applicant must have completed 18 credit hours at TBCC, maintain a 2.5 GPA, enroll in at least 6 credit hours per term, and demonstrate financial need. Funds are split over fall, winter, and spring terms, and can be used for tuition, fees, and books.

Ross and Joanne Tomlin Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to support an existing TBCC student, with preference given to a student enrolled in the Forestry or Natural Resources Program. Applicant must have completed 18 credit hours at TBCC, maintain a 2.5 GPA and enroll in at least 6 credit hours per term. Funds are split over fall, winter, and spring terms and can be used for tuition, fees, books, educational supplies, childcare, and living expenses.

Teach for Tillamook Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to support a student who is enrolled in the AAOT-Education program with intent to return to Tillamook County and teach in one of the school districts within the County. Applicants must enroll in at least 6 credit hours per term and maintain a 3.0 GPA. Funds are split between fall, winter, and spring terms, and can be used for tuition, fees, books, educational supplies, childcare, and living expenses.

The Bootstrap Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to support a TBCC student without financial or moral familial support, pursuing an education in a science related field, and who intends to transfer to a four-year university. Funds will be distributed over two academic years, and may be used for tuition, fees, books, educational supplies, childcare and living expenses.

Tillamook Coast Outdoor Program Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to support a student who is pursuing an education in the nature and outdoors or math and science learning communities. Funds are split between fall, winter, and spring terms, and can be used for tuition, fees, books, educational supplies and living expenses.

Tillamook County Master Gardeners Association Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to assist a TBCC student who is interested in the field of horticulture, natural resources, or agriculture. Funds are split between fall, winter and spring terms and can be used for tuition, fees, books, educational supplies, childcare and living expenses.

Tillamook County Pioneer Museum Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is a two-year scholarship and is intended to help a deserving TBCC student embark on an educational journey to acquire critical thinking, and an ability to synthesize diverse information in the fields of history or the humanities. Applicant must maintain a GPA of 3.0, enroll in 6 credits per term and demonstrate financial need. During their second term, the scholarship recipient is encouraged to log 10 hours of volunteer time with an organization that needs volunteers. Funds are split between fall, winter, and spring terms, and can be used for tuition, fees, and books.

Tillamook Rotary Club Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to assist a TBCC degree or certificate seeking student. Applicant must maintain a 2.0 GPA, enroll in a minimum of 6 credit hours per term. Funds are split between fall, winter, and spring terms and can be used for tuition, fees, books, educational expenses, living expenses, and childcare.

Tillamook Masonic Lodge Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to assist a second year TBCC student to continue their educational goals through courses at TBCC. Applicant must have completed 36 credit hours at TBCC, maintain a 2.5 GPA, enroll in at least 8 credit hours per term, and demonstrate financial need. Funds are split between fall, winter, and spring terms, and can only be used for tuition, fees, and books.

Tillamook Masonic Lodge CTE Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to assist a TBCC student pursuing a degree or certificate in a Career Technical Education (CTE) field: Welding, Manufacturing and Industrial Technology or Electrician Apprenticeship Technologies. Funds are split between fall, winter, and spring terms, and can be used for tuition, fees, books, and educational expenses.

Virgil Chadwick Agricultural Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to support a student at TBCC seeking a career in agriculture or dairy. Applicant must be a resident of Tillamook County for at least 4 years, must enroll in at least 6 credit hours per term, and maintain a 2.75 GPA. Funds are split between fall, winter, and spring terms, and can be used for tuition, fees, books, and educational supplies.
